

RULES FOR USE OF THE HALL

An American Homesteading Foundation Facility

A. General Policy of Use

1. The Village Hall and facilities are provided by the American Homesteading Foundation (AHF) primarily for use by its members and associated groups. The following rules provide a means for the orderly use of the facility.
2. A proper application form, completely filled out, is required. The application is necessary to provide for scheduling and approval.
3. The AHF Board reserves the right to waive the requirements or rules if a special situation arises. The Board also reserves the right to accept or reject an application.
4. Proper safeguards to the building and equipment must be observed by all users. These include:
 - (a) Proper operation of the air conditioner/heater control. Read and understand instructions posted under the thermostat.
 - (b) Ensuring that all exit doors are unlocked while Hall is in use. Re-secure upon departure.
 - (c) Before leaving, check to make sure that all electrical equipment, except refrigerator, is turned off.
5. Please leave Hall in as good condition as you found it with all furniture replaced as found. Cleaning supplies located in unlocked closet in Hall.
